ALERT: NLRB REQUIRED US TO PROVIDE THE UNION YOUR HOME ADDRESS, EMAIL AND PHONE NUMBER(S) IF YOU ARE A VOTER IN THE OCTOBER 24TH ELECTION



- Mercy Health VNS does <u>not</u> supply personal information, including your home. address, cell phone or email to anyone <u>until we are ordered to do</u> so by a Court or government agency, like the NLRB.
- However, since the union asked for an election, we were required to provide that information to the union today.
- Mercy does <u>not</u> send people to your home for <u>any</u> reason. IF someone visits your home pretending to be from Mercy, they are not telling you the truth.

A good safety practice is to ask anyone who comes to your door to show you ID and business card, *and* confirm they are who they say they are with their employer <u>before</u> letting them into your home.

- If they are in fact from the union they have no more rights than any other door-to-door salesman, and you do not have to speak to them. Whether you do or not is entirely your choice.
- You do not have to answer the phone or text messages. It's up to you.
- You do not have to tell ANYONE if you are voting, or how you are voting.
- If you feel threatened or harassed you can send a "No Solicitation" form to the union, and/or report it to the NLRB or the authorities.
